Revisions to Section 8 of the Regulations of the University – Student Conduct

Topic and purpose of the paper

- 1 APRC is requested to **consider** and, if thought appropriate, **approve** a number of revisions to Section 8 of the Regulations, Student Conduct, to take effect from the academic session 2011/12.

Outline of the proposed changes

- 2 The majority of the proposed changes to Section 8 of the University Regulations are minor in nature, and have been undertaken to reflect the nomenclature in other areas of the University Regulations and Codes of Practice.
- 3 References to two additional Codes of Practice have been added:
 - (i) The Code of Practice on the Conduct of Centrally Co-ordinated Formal Written Examinations
 - (ii) The Code of Practice on Suspension from Study on Health Grounds.
- 4 The final amendment is to section 8.3.5 which now includes a specific reference to serious plagiarism and the Code of Practice on Plagiarism.
- 5 A non-tracked change version of the Regulations document is attached at Appendix 1. A tracked change version is attached at Appendix 2.
