Report on Chair's Action taken between February and April 2012

Topic and Purpose of the paper

Chair's Actions

- 2 The following actions to approve amendments to legislation were taken between February and April 2012:
 - a. Action taken on 14 February 2012 to amend the University Regulations and to make a recommendation to Senate to amend the University Ordinances, with reference to Dual Degrees;
 - b. Action taken on 14 February 2012 to approve the final draft of the Code of Practice on Placement Learning;
 - c. Action taken on 27 February 2012 to amend the University Regulations 7.2.6 (i) to reflect the position on the recording of marks where a student is permitted to retake a module in which they have already gained credit;
 - d. Action taken on 21 March 2012 to amend the Code of Practice on Plagiarism. This Action relates to a clarification of the definition of Poor Academic Practice, in order to align with advice that has previously been given to Schools and students.
- 3 The following actions to approve exemptions from the legislation were taken between February and April 2012
 - a. Action taken on 13 March 2012 to approve an exemption from Regulation 6.1.2 (p) (iv) for the BSc Psychology, MSci Psychology and Psychological Practice and MSci Psychology and Psychological Research.
