  - 5. Sphorakiois: a spelling found in SC on Sept. 23 but not on this date.

  - 12. Artemon: Oct. 8 no. 5 or Nov. 9 no. 2? celui du 8 oct, est aussi fête à d'autre dates, p. ex. Martinianos: pro Martinosous.
  - 23. Peter: np. Cobst: 224 panditheh cofrectornofil bema26Tn302. Petros Kapetoloeon. ( Synch vat cryor ig has P. Alex. on 23 : no of, on 25).
  - 25. Peter: patriarch of Alexandria, SC no. 2. eronce to better the Resychast? (me. 18)
  - 29. Theodoulos: I idientified the reference in Vienna Th. Gr. 302 et soc. with the stybite of Dec.8, no 6.: but this reference makes it appear that the ascetic of that date , comm. no. 5 is intended in this tradition.
- Dec. 17. the specification of John as bishop gives a little more indication of the origin of this note: it seems to me that the first bishop of this name, tenant of the see during the imprisonment of Euthymius and his subsequent martyrdom, is the most likely candidate. there is no trace, so far as I can trace, of his being a confessor: but his upholding of
- ikonodouleia in a dangerous time may have led to veneration.

- 31. Neophytos: nothing to be found of this name on this date. Versy 19 has Menadores and Neophytos
- pril 2. Epiphanios: this corruption is found also in Vienna Gr. Th. 302 sec.
  - 3. Niketas; the epithet Ho en tois Puthiois is not found in SC -does its presence change the identification from that of SC no. 1?
  - 7. Eirene and Chionia: SC April 16, also 3 and 6 in certain mss.
  - 8. Herodion etc: a fuller list of names is given in ms.D (col,592 l.46) but Epaphras (known here in Vienna GT 302 soc.) is foreign to it.

  - 12. Gerontios: this reference substantiates in a measure the conjecture of Baumstark that here a derivation of the martyr of April 14 (SC no.4) is to be found.

30. Euphemias ktl: the origin of this reference is clearly the commemoration of Eusebius Romanus and others in the church of s. Euphemia (Syn. onst. no.

31. Eustabbios: presumably the patriarch of CP 1019 -1025 who is not however commemorated in Syn. onst. nor mentioned in BHG: no Vita ! 7

6. Mamelchthe: October 5 no. 2. Not on this date elsewhere.

8. Paul of Kaiouma: not in Syn. Const. Specified as martyr in BHG 1471.

9. Kyrillos Alexandreias: main commemoration in January, but also found on dates in June, as in mss.D al. of Syn. Const, at the Auto. op. Val. 320. ibid. Phortounatus: on this date as in Vienna Gr Th. 302 and ms. N of Syn. Const.

ibid. Hypatios: Syn. Const. June 17 no. 2 and May 29. Not on this date.

12. Quadratus in the Rundeia: untraceable

21. Justus (and Matthaios), Frophimus and Theophilos: Syn. Const. July 21, nos. 6&7 July 4. Theodotos of Cyrene: Theodoros of C (Syn. Const. no. 2) ut vid. but cp. no. 4 5(Martha) mother of Symeon Stylites (junior): on this day as in mss.pler.

  - 13. Stephanos the Sabaite: as in ms. N (normally Oct. 28, no. 8)

  - 20. For the addition of Elisha cp. Vienna Gr. Th. 302 on June 14. where the addition of Elijah is likewise elsewhere unattested.
- 24. Anatolios: a martyr of this name, with a companion Protoleon, is commemorat on April 23 in mss. McMo/of Syn. Const. The patriarch Anatolios was not a martyr. (July 3)
  - 26. Hermulos = Hermolaos (SC no.1)
  - 28. Timon is mentioned (along with) the others in ms. McMdMoMt.
  - 30. Gelasios: no saint of this name commemorated on this day A transference of the martyr of February 26 (27/28): another thus named is commemorated on June 6.
  - August. 9. Matthaios: in Syn. Const. Matthias
    - 16. Mandelios: I cannot trace this figure insSChor BHG: but have located a commemoration on this day in a selective menology in gospel ms. 703 (Bixby gospels, Huntington Library) ibid. Sarakenoi: Syn. Const. has Agarenoi ms. 7 (896, 145-46) Anacost Agarenoi.
    - 24. Eutuches: found in a number of mss.on this day, in some Eutuchios, in some named as here.
    - 27. tou hosiou Kordoubas; a corruption of Hosios bishop of Kordouba (in many mss. Kodroubes, but oddly enough in its correct form here)
    - 28. Saba: see notes on Vienna Gr. Th. 302 for Aug. 27.
    - 29. Photius: no holy man of this name known on this date: a probable corruption of Phantinos (Nov. 14, no. 5) who however is not otherwise known on this date, but on Aug. 30 (31) man. Bc R Mc Md Mo Mt (Cg 31)
