Fragment of a Kūfic *Qur'ān*, written probably in the 8th or 9th century; fairly thick parchment, light-brownish colour; written in black and red ink, diacritical points partly in red, between the *sūras* ornaments in red, and first words in red.

Size: 338 × 217 mm.; fols. 9; different numbers of lines.
