| Overview | <p>The purpose of the project is to develop learning communities where students will share experiences and learn from each other. This project will provide a modular structure within WebCT to enable the students working in learning communities to work with neurological case studies. The elements of the unit will include media clips, text, references and discussion pages, enabling the students to prepare a presentation of their case to the other learning communities. Material generated will then be available within WebCT for all participating students and a record of their learning trail will be posted to discussion groups.</p> <p>With increasing numbers of students, the development of a web based managed learning environment will enable the student to develop independent study skills, whilst working within a defined group with a designated tutor.</p> | | | |
