

**116. MS 1181 (N 25)**

Persian text of the *Kitāb-i Naṣa'ib-i Mawlavī*, apparently a treatise on Sufi Islamic Spirituality based on the *Maṣnavī-ī ma'navī* of Jalāl al-Din Rūmī, copied, according to the colophon, fol. 66r, by a named Ottoman scribe.<sup>82</sup>

66 text pages, with several more unused; paper, 22.2 x 14 cm. Fol. 1v: gilded frontispiece; gilded borderlines through the manuscript.

Binding: Brown leather with an ornate gilded design of flowers within an elaborate vase, and corner motifs. The same back and front. On the spine is a gilded diaper design with flowers.
